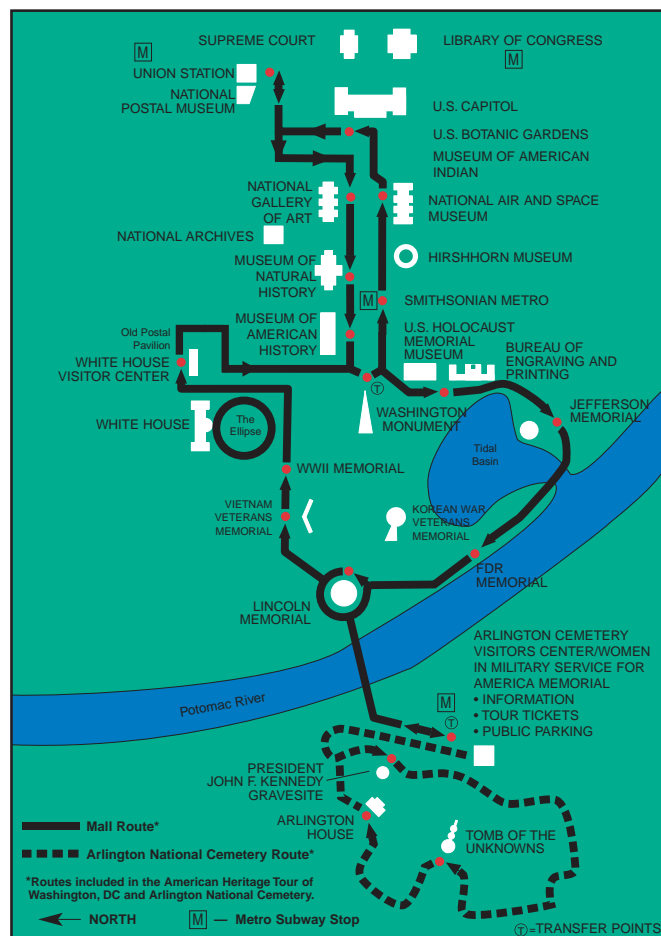

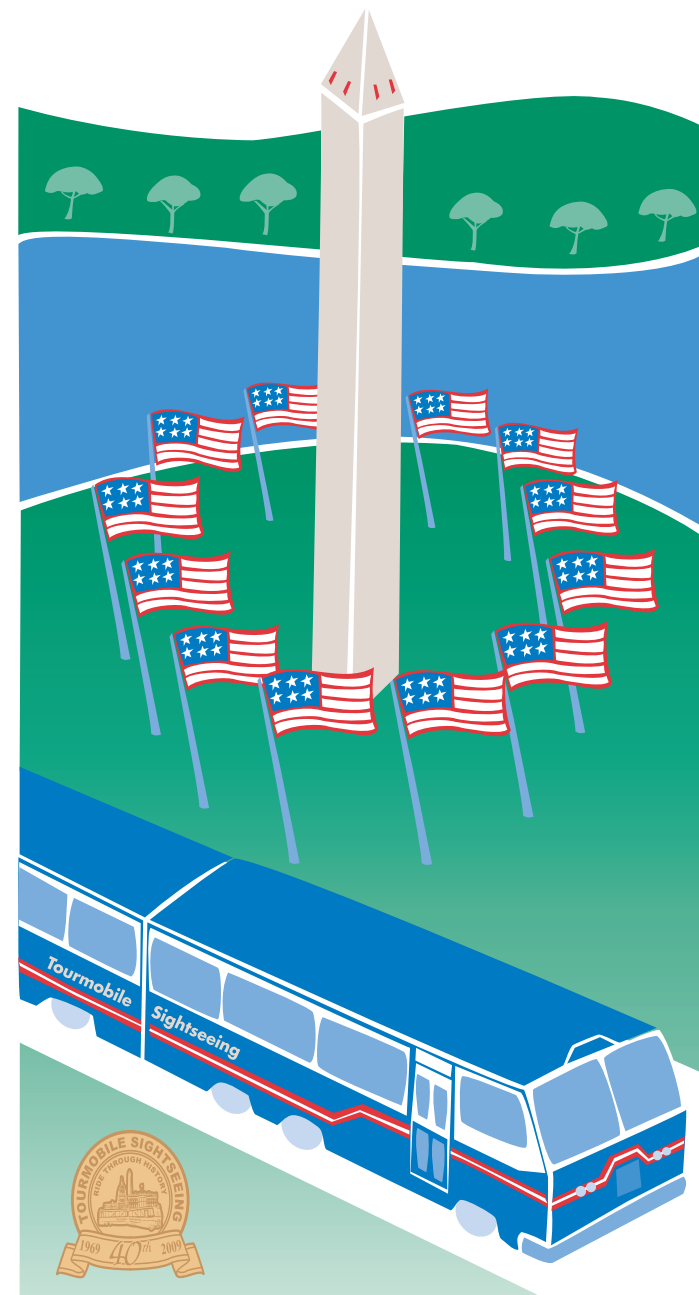

MOBILITY IMPAIRED SERVICES

TourmobileSM provides two types of services for individuals who are mobility challenged.

For those individuals who are able to transfer from their wheel chair and can climb two or three steps, we provide our *on-demand service*. Vehicles used on all TourmobileSM tours are equipped with priority seating and wheel chair storage. Individuals may board at any TourmobileSM stop on any vehicle.

For those individuals who require a chair lift, we provide our *on-call service*. Individuals should either make their request for a lift-equipped vehicle with a TourmobileSM employee located at any of our ticket booths or on board any of our vehicles at any TourmobileSM stop. Your request will be processed and a lift-equipped vehicle will be dispatched to your location. You may get off at the stops of your choice and then arrange a reboarding time with your driver.

To help us serve you better, you may make a reservation for a lift-equipped vehicle when you know your plans in advance or obtain further information about our lift-equipped vehicle service, by calling us at 703-979-0690 between 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. daily except December 25.

FREDERICK DOUGLASS TOUR

Visit Cedar Hill, the newly restored home of former slave Frederick Douglass, who became a statesman, orator and advisor to Presidents. Ride through historic Capitol Hill, past Lincoln Park and the Mary McLeod Bethune Memorial. A unique tour of African-American history.
